Where the money went.....

During the academic year September 2014 –July 2015, Fort Royal received a Primary Sports Grant of £5,023. The aim of this grant is to improve the quality of PE and sports activities offered to pupils.

This year we have enhanced the opportunities for physical activity during lunch and playtimes to increase daily participation. There has been fantastic improvements to our outside facilities which provide essential learning opportunities away from the classroom.

Our Play Dale area has had a revamp and looks spectacular. A contribution of £2000 went towards this project which has made a significant impact at playtimes. Children have embraced the equipment and are thriving in this area, it reflects well our whole school ethos 'PLAY LEARN LAUGH SUCCEED' with it being used for imaginative play, fine and gross motor skill development, independence, communication, building friendships to name a few.

Another popular playground activity is trikes and bikes. We have purchased £1000 worth of bikes which the children enjoy and is a real motivator for many of our pupils. Children benefit by developing their coordination, play skills and when particular bikes are popular begin to develop taking turns and waiting which are important life skills to learn. Some of the bikes are double seated and are in the chariot style so children can develop sharing and working together.
