Welcome back for a very short term! This term the theme of our topic is '**Animal Antics**'.

- In **Literacy** we are studying non-fiction books about farms and how these books are different from story books. We will also be exploring the story of **Farmer Duck** during our reading sessions.
- For **Numeracy** we will be continuing with our number work and how we can use our number skills to help us solve problems practically. We will also be focusing on the properties of shape and naming common and 2d and 3d shapes.
- Through our **Animal Antics** topic we will be exploring animals that live on the farm, their habitats, and young and how to look after them. We will also be using a range of materials, natural and man-made, inside and outside the classroom, to create artwork linked to our topic.
