#### Parent Code of Conduct - Quick Guide

#### Our aim:

At Fort Royal School, we work in partnership with families to provide a safe and supportive learning environment for all pupils, who have SEND and additional vulnerabilities. All adults must follow this code of conduct to ensure a positive and respectful school community.

# **Expectations for parents, carers, Family members and friends:**

- Treat all staff, pupils, and families with respect.
- Support the school's values and work with staff for the benefit of your child.
- Ensure appropriate behaviour and supervision of your child on-site.
- Follow school procedures for drop-off, pick-up, parking, and site safety.
- Respect school property and keep the environment clean.
- Alcohol, smoking, vaping, and mobile phone use are prohibited on-site.

# Drop-off and pick-up:

- Follow site staff directions and safety procedures.
- Park and drive safely max speed limit is 5 mph.
- You need a permit to come onto site,
- Pupils must be collected by 3:15 pm; inform the office if delayed.

### Inappropriate behaviour that will not be tolerated:

- Swearing, abusive language, or raising voices.
- Aggressive gestures, threats, intimidation, or violence.
- Discrimination, bullying, or harassment (offline or online).
- Smoking, alcohol, vaping or illegal substances on school premises.
- Unsafe or disruptive behaviour that affects school operations.
- Filming or photographing without permission.

# **Managing Inappropriate Behaviour:**

• Concerns should be raised with the school office, not directly with other parents.

- Inappropriate behaviour may result in a meeting with the headteacher.
- Serious incidents could lead to being barred from school premises, police involvement, or legal action.

# **Barring from School Premises:**

- The school may bar individuals who pose a risk to the school community.
- Affected individuals will receive written notice and can appeal the decision.
- Reviews of the bar will be conducted periodically.

All parents receive a copy of this Code of Conduct and must follow it to ensure a safe, respectful school environment for all.
