Connect-a-Scooter - Set of 4

ABOUT THE EQUIPMENT: Tongue and groove interlocking edges allow scooters to be joined. With safety handles to help keep user in position and hands away from wheels. Bold, bright colours. Scooter boards give kids vestibular and proprioceptive input. For kids that are sensory seekers, scooter boards can help them feel regulated and balanced quickly. These scooter boards can also be used to to gently push those more sensitive to movement to tolerate it better. They also create the opportunity to work on higher level sensory integration skills such as bilateral coordination, crossing midline, and integrating some reflexes.
