CLASS 3

We have had a fantastic start to the year, we are incredibly proud of how well the children have settled into their new classroom and routines. In literacy, we have been exploring '*Things I Like*' by Anthony Browne, using props and objects to support exploration and communication of likes and preferences.

In maths, the children have enthusiastically joined in with counting songs and number rhymes, including '*Five Little Ducks*' and '*Five Speckled Frogs*', developing their counting through singing and actions. In topic, we have explored Cubism and created some wonderful artwork using collage, painting, sculpture and mark making.

It has been lovely to see the children growing in confidence, building relationships and enjoying new experiences.

CLASS 7

We have been exploring the story *Five Minutes' Peace*. We have been acting out and role-playing the main characters, responding to others through talking, and creating playdough models of the characters.

We have also been learning about counting and numbers. Some of the students have been estimating and predicting numbers, then checking their answers by counting.
